- Falls off chair
- Knocks on things off desk.
- Generally disorganized.
- Clumsy, awkward, uncoordinated movements.
- Distractibility.
- Short attention span.
- Intolerance to stress/ easily frustrated.
- Daydreaming or inattentiveness (hearing is adequate).
- Irritability.
- Frequent mood swings.
- Aggressive behavior- bumps or pushes others.
- Aversion to touch.
- Avoidance of messy activities.
- Hyperactivity- in constant motion without purpose.
- Hypoactivity- slow moving.
- Speech and language problems.
- Poor fine motor coordination.
- Normal intelligence but trouble learning to read or do mathematics.
- Overreacts to physically painful experiences.
- Underreacts to physically painful experiences.
- Irritated in crowds and isolates themselves.
- Demonstrates difficulty on stairs.
- Often rocks in chair.
- Avoids fast moving activities.
- Sensitivity to movement and often is dizzy.
- Difficulty with manual skills as cutting or coloring.
- Frequently falls.
- Appears stiff and rigid.
- Appears loose and floppy.
- Tires easily.
- Frightened by loud noises.
- Often shouts.
- Sensitive to light.
- Difficulty discriminating shapes or colors.
- Cannot follow a moving object.
- Often squints or rubs eyes.
- Overly sensitive to certain smells.
- Difficulty discriminating smells.
- Difficulty organizing or structuring activities.
