

CLASSROOM STRATEGIES

CONTROL THE ENVIRONMENT

- -Reduce sensory overloads by minimizing stimuli in the room.
- -Sit child where he/she will feel safer (maybe by placing them away from others).
- -Place child at the head of the table.
- -Have less clutter on bulletin boards and around the room.

MANAGE THE CLASSROOM

- -Develop a consistent routine.
- -Plan transitions as if they were lessons.
- -Use clapping or a beat to signify the end or start of an activity.
- -Provide movement breaks between activities.
- -Simplify activities and make eye- contact during instructions.
- -Respect the childs needs.
